# REPLACING THE AIR CONDITIONER IN THE CHURCH

Recently our finance committee members were busy trying to obtain a Government Grant to help finance the replacement of the air conditioner in the Church. We would like to announce that they have been successful. Well done gentlemen. So now, using the funds obtained from the grant and the money donated previously by our wonderful parishioners, we are happy to let you know that the replacement air conditioner will now become a reality. We will also have enough funds to be able to install an air conditioner in the choir loft for our musicians. The downside of this however, is that because of the amount of work that is involved in this project, staring from Monday, 13th July, the Church will be closed for a week. If all goes well, it will be opened again for the 9am Mass on Saturday, 18th July. That means there will be <u>NO WEEKDAY MASSES AT ALL</u> for that week. We had thought of having Mass in the hall but because of the current situation, that was not possible. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause, but it will be nice to have an air conditioner that works properly.

### **BOOKINGS FOR WEEKEND MASSES**

As from 1st July, restrictions have been lifted even further for religious services. Unfortunately St Matthew's is a small Church so we are only legally able to accommodate 65 people per Mass. Therefore, bookings are still essential. These bookings can be made by contacting the Parish office via email or phone. If you have made a booking through the office, your name is placed on the attendance sheet for you. Please tick next to your name when you arrive. If you wish to attend the same Mass next week, you can write (next week or NW) against your name and then the booking will be moved across to the following weekend. Alternatively you can rebook by contacting the parish office during the week. Bookings are not required for weekday Masses.
