
FROM THE DESK OF FR ROBERT:

VOLUNTEERS

At the moment we are trying to limit the number of people involved in the liturgy of the Mass to help reduce possible transmissions. Once the restrictions are eased further, we will then be calling on our wonderful volunteers. We are hoping that on the first weekend in August, we will be able to have the liturgies back to their past joyous celebrations, We will however give volunteers ample warning if this is possible. At the moment we only require one reader/commentator per Mass so if you would like to volunteer for the Mass you are attending, please let the priest know when you arrive.



Recently our finance committee members were busy trying to obtain a Government Grant to help finance the replacement of the air conditioner in the Church. We would like to announce that they have been successful. Well done gentlemen. So now, using the funds obtained from the grant and the money donated previously by our wonderful parishioners, we are happy to let you know that the replacement air conditioner will now become a reality. We will also have enough funds to be able to install an air conditioner in the choir loft for our musicians. The downside of this however, is that because of the amount of work that is involved in this project, staring from Monday, 13th July, the Church will be closed for a week. If all goes well, it will be opened again for the 9am Mass on Saturday, 18th July. That means there will be <u>NO WEEKDAY MASSES AT ALL</u> for that week. We had thought of having Mass in the hall but because of the current situation, that was not possible. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause, but it will be nice to have an air conditioner that works properly.
