
COVID-19 DIOCESAN UPDATE

NSW Health has revised the COVID-19 guidelines for places of worship effective from 7 December 2020. 1) Places of Worship and Religious Services

The maximum number of people at places of worship and religious services will only be limited by the 2 square metre rule.



There will be no upper cap on the number of people who can attend weddings and funerals, provided the new 2 square metre rule is adhered to.



Up to 50 singers/performers will be permitted to sing indoors. There will be no maximum cap for outdoor singing. Congregations may sing, but NSW Health continues to ask that anyone 12 years or older to wear a mask.

With these new guidelines, St Matthew's Church can now accommodate 140 people.
