JRS REFUGEE FOODBANK SERVICE

gee Foodbank has delivered over 6,773 grocery parcels and every week our food bank currently feeds over 900 people. COVID-19 DIOCESAN UPDATE

Religious Services

Effective from Monday, 23rd November the maximum number of people at an outdoor religious service must not exceed 500 subject to the one person per 2 square metre rule for assigned seating or 4 square metre rule for informal seating. Outdoor services (up to 500 people) can be held at the same time as indoor services (up to 300 people). People attending will be required to still provide their name and contact details for tracing purposes if needed. It is strongly recommended that people attending services in the places of worship, wear a mask.

<u>Choir</u>

Up to 30 singers permitted outdoors and 5 for indoor singing. The choir should be facing forward, be 1.5metres apart and at least 5 metres from the congregation.

<u>Singing</u>

Congregations may sing, but everyone 12 years or older must wear a mask.

Funerals and Weddings

Because of the 4 square metre rule, this has not changed for our Church.
