JOURNEY OF LIFE AND DEATH

The gospel story this Sunday is about the transfiguration (Mt.17:1-9) which was

an amazing event in Jesus' life. The apostles were completely overcome when a glimpse of Christ in all his glory is revealed. A voice calls out: "This is my beloved Son, listen to him.' From now on till the resurrection of Christ, the apostles will witness the highs and lows: from the miracles in Galilee, praise and adulation for his teachings in Capernaum to the agony in Gethsemane and crucifixion on Calvary and the Resurrection.

We are not meant to be spectators at the transfiguration but, like the apostles, walk with Jesus and climb the mountain and witness: see with our hearts and minds and listen to the voice inviting us to believe in God's beloved Son. We are to reflect on its message and live it out with conviction and sincerity. It was only through his passion and death that Christ came to the glory of the resurrection. If he is to transfigure our wretched bodies and make them into copies of his own glorious body, then the road we must journey is one of suffering taken by Christ. He also provides the glory in store for us, if we have faith and trust in the promises of the Lord.

Lent provides us opportunities to confront ourselves with the many false securities we hold dear and are unwilling to shed on our pilgrim journey. It is also a season of great blessing, helping us to grow into truthful, generous, and loving people through sacrifice and self-denial. This requires patience and is the work of a lifetime because nothing that is worthwhile is ever simple or straightforward.
