At the heart of the gospel story of the Samaritan woman at the well in deep conversation with Jesus is the thirsting desire for true happiness. Thirst knows no boundaries


as Jesus who is physically thirsty is asking a Samaritan woman for a drink and in return she is astonished to know that he could provide her water that would last forever; that inner thirst that no earthly water could satisfy.

Without a note of condemnation, Jesus helped her to look at her deeply troubled life and helped her to unburdened her soul. He gave her hope and offered her nothing less than the living waters of friendship and the Spirit of God which leads to eternal life. That saving love of God poured into our hearts enables us to find life and peace. Thirst stands for absence of God into our lives- that unsatisfied longing within every heart. St. Augustine talks about 'Our hearts are restless until they find their rest in God. '

The woman's past did not hinder from coming close to Christ. Jesus won her over by gently leading her out of herself and raising her mind and her heart to higher things. By asking for a drink of water, Jesus restored her dignity and changed her life. She spoke of Jesus to all in the neighbourhood and became the bearer of the good news that Jesus is the Saviour.

When we were baptized, we received this saving water of life. As life goes on, we need to be constantly in touch with this fountain of living water which Jesus gave us. He is always at hand to refresh us and may our Lenten journey lead us in search for the unending, the unchanging and the eternal.
