After the crucifixion of Jesus, the disciples are struggling to make sense of

their disappointment, they felt that they had nothing to look forward to. As the two disciples depart from the place where their hopes were severely shattered, the dejected disciples were joined by a stranger who listened sympathetically to their sorry tale and helped them to see meaning through the scriptures in all that had happened. It was only when they pressed him to stay and in the breaking of the bread that they recognized his presence. Their faith restored, they returned to Jerusalem with new-found enthusiasm.

This story relates to our own when many times we walk with downcast faces due to quarrels and misunderstanding at home or in the workplace or the loneliness of being rejected? All this time we forget that Jesus walks with us. We may lose many opportunities to recognize the Lord's presence in our lives.

We meet the Lord amidst the ordinariness of human life, in the relationships we establish as we work and share together. At mass Jesus invites us to share the eucharist with him. At table as we break the Word and share the bread, we also bring our joys and sorrows and listen to Him speaking to us.

We pray that our eyes be opened, and our minds enlightened to recognize Jesus so that we are in a position to set out and proclaim the good news that love is alive, that God lives indeed as always is and will be.
